



American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 City of Levelland, Texas

U.S. Department of Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) \$57,576.00

The City of Levelland was awarded \$57,576.00 from the U.S. Department of Energy through the Texas Comptroller's Office, State Energy Conservation Office.

The City of Levelland will implement the City Hall Retrofit/Variable Frequency Drive Project with these funds. Currently, Levelland City Hall has five HVAC units that are very outdated and energy inefficient. The City is seeking to replace the (3) 8 SEER and (2) 10 SEER HVAC units with new 13 SEER energy efficient units which in turn will create a savings for the City of Levelland in the long run. Also, Levelland City Hall has outdated and energy inefficient lighting fixtures which will be replaced with new energy efficient lamps and fixtures. Lastly, the City of Levelland will add a Variable Frequency Drive on a 75 HP pump at the Hickory Street Pump Station which will also save energy in the long run.

This project would not be possible without the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act. This project will provide for a greener more efficient Levelland and in turn will result in energy savings which will result in tax payer dollar savings.

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
