The City of Levelland was awarded a \$14,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Energy through the Texas Railroad Commission. The grant will reimburse the City of Levelland up to \$14,000 for the cost of converting two city vehicles to propane. This project will allow the City of Levelland to test the newest technology available when it comes to propane conversion kits without any local funds.

Should this pilot program prove to be successful, the City of Levelland will look at purchasing propane powered vehicles in the future. Compared with vehicles fueled with conventional diesel and gasoline, propane vehicles can produce significantly lower amounts of harmful emissions and the greenhouse gas carbon dioxide.
