

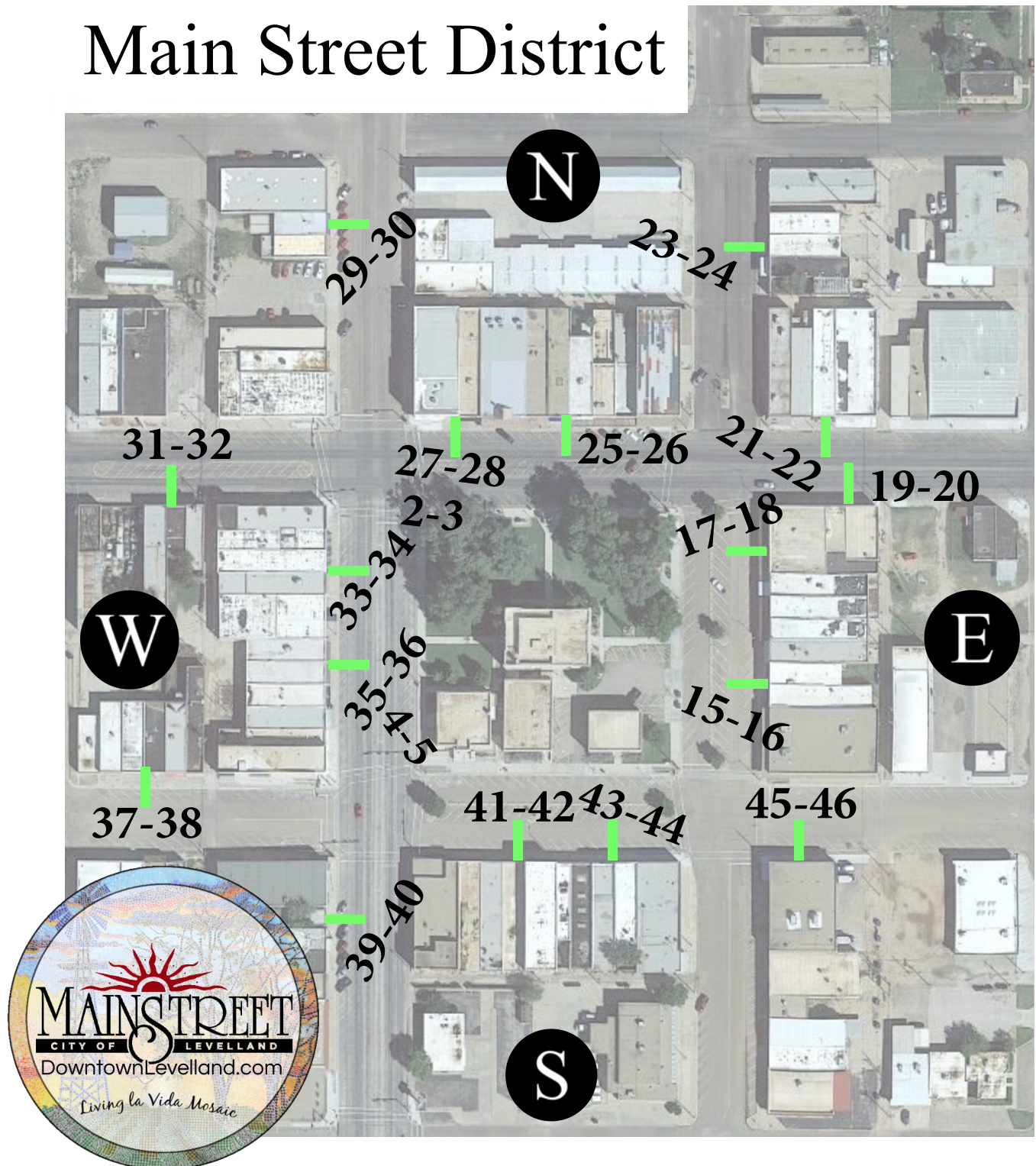

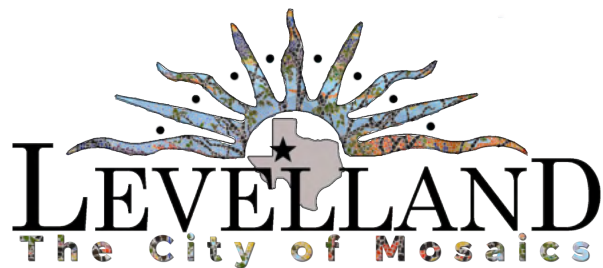

The Artist...Pauline Mills:

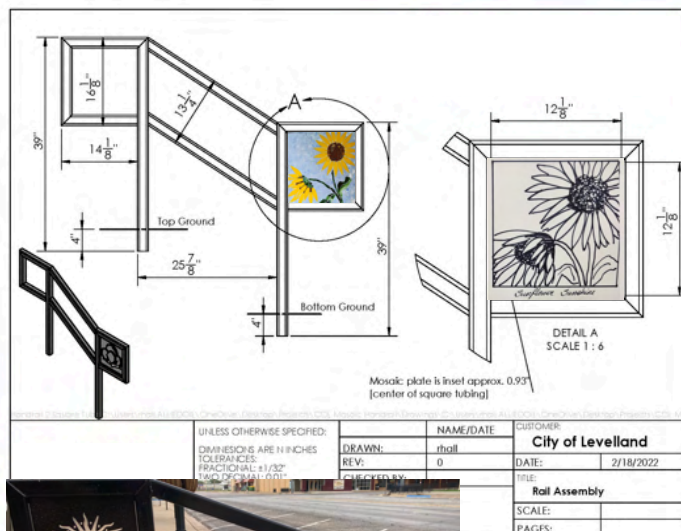
Born & raised in Cork City, Ireland, Pauline came to America in 1986 to seek her fortune and found it in mosaics!

New Morning Mosaic by John & Bette Hope

Hockley City, Texas, surveyed and platted in 1912 by C.W. Post, would change its name to Levelland, in 1922, and become the county seat.

Levelland has several claims to fame including SPC Creative Arts Department which has graduated students that have gone on to become famous recording artists. It's also known for it's premiere Industrial Railpark and in 1968 gave birth to its first mosaic.

Mosaics date back 6,000 years as an art technique in which cubes of glass tile are fixed in a pattern to make a work of art. Each mosaic in Levelland pays homage to its history, industry, education and culture.

On March 27, 2019, the Governor of the State of Texas, presented Levelland with a Concurrent Resolution, approved by the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas, it be resolved that Levelland is designated as the official...
