



The History

Hockley City, Texas, surveyed & platted in 1912 by C.W. Post, would change its name to Levelland, in 1922, and become the county seat.

In 1968, Levelland gave birth to its first mosaic. Mosaics date back 6,000 years as an art technique in which cubes of glass tile are fixed in a pattern to make a work of art. Each mosaic in Levelland pays homage to its history, industry, education, land and culture.

After fifty years, on March 27, 2019, the Governor presented Levelland with a Concurrent Resolution, approved by the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas, that the City of Levelland is officially designated as...
